## Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord

Dear Parish Family:

Promises, Promises, Promises, that's all I get is promises! How many times have we heard this from our loved ones, friends, co-workers and the promises never come to fulfillment. Someone once said to me, "Promises are like snow balls, easy to be made hard to keep." It's our nature to always make promises especially when we are in some particular situation. In actuality, promises can give us a sense of hope. It gives us energy to continue to be hopeful and to continue moving on with our lives.

In our Gospel today, the Story of the Transfiguration of Jesus, the apostles, Peter, James and John were given an extraordinary experience of Jesus' divinity. He seems to give them an experience as a promise of encouragement to them, so that when they were experiencing difficult times, they could remember Jesus in his glory, and be strengthened in their faith and their hope. This promise of being transformed would have been a great source of consolation to them.

There is no doubt that we need to rely on promises to help our lives to keep moving each day. Hopefully, when we celebrate the Eucharist, when we listen and follow the Word of God from the scriptures, and practice regularly the Sacraments, we are creating the means of allowing the promises of God's peace and love to truly be experienced. Someone once said, "we need a mountaintop experience," times where we can truly pray, times of quietness, times to experience the beauty of things that surround our lives that we never had the opportunity to appreciate them. All of these little mountain experiences can give us hope. There's no doubt, we need to be hopeful people to survive in this world filled with turmoil and pain. We need to develop a habit of thinking about what is good and beautiful so hope becomes a reality for us.

The promise that Jesus makes for us is one that today's Feast truly testifies too, that one day we will share in the great promise of everlasting life.
