21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parish Family:

Life is full of surprises! There are so many things that surround our lives each day that we don't understand. What's interesting is the fact we don't understand why we don't understand. So often, we think we should be able to comprehend everything that exists. Of course, over the years, we have come to understand many things, especially the human body to some degree, like what is good for one's health and what causes certain illnesses. There are times we run into areas where we either disagree with one another, or where we have no idea where the answer lies.

But when it comes to thinking about God, we all become experts. So often we say, if I were God, I would do things differently. The truth of the matter is we do not understand many things in life, and we can never truly understand the mind of God. Even St. Paul indicates; "O the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! For who has known the mind of the Lord?
