Dear Parish Family:

Correcting someone is the last thing we all like to do. Yet our reading today tells us that it's our obligation to correct or help straighten out another. Again, it is not that easy. How many times have we used excuses to get out of this obligation? "Live and let Live" or "Give him enough rope and he'll hang himself" or "Mind your own business". True, it is not easy to correct others, but how do we help them to understand their ways, especially when comes to our own family members?

Well, Jesus gives us some tips on how to go about that. He says, when you talk to the one in error, just keep it between the two of you. There's no need to make it public. Just work at it quietly, together. Gossiping is not another alternative. If that fails, then bring somebody else with you, or suggest going and seeing someone a bit more professional for the help. If that fails, then we must pray for the possibility of conversion in that person.

If someone comes to you out of love, to help you become a better person by giving you some further insight into your behavior, then isn't this cause for gratitude? Someone has loved you enough and been brave enough, to want the best for you. That person has risked being misunderstood by coming to you. That in itself is an act of love.

Again, it's not always easy to help correct a loved one, but we must if we truly love that person. Let us pray that the Lord will always give us the courage and patience to commit ourselves in these acts of love for one another.
