Dear Parish Family,

I'm sure that all of us are familiar with love letters. Letters we send with special meaning to those we dearly love to express our feelings for them. But sometimes, love letters are not always endearing, but rather they can express disappointment and even notifying the other of a possible breakup. Many times, these letters lack a sense of passion for the other; I guess that's why they call them "Dear John" letters.

As followers of Jesus, we are called to live lives of passion. Jesus always emphasizes how important it was to love God with all our hearts and never hold anything back. Give everything that is in you to this love for God and for neighbor. Like Jesus who loved us with great passion, so too, it's this kind of love we need to cultivate in our lives. We began this love when we were baptized. We promised to pledge our love for God and for one another. May we always be persistent in our daily prayer, to allow God to shape us into people of love and compassion for God and for one another.

Once again, our Nurses Ministry is asking our parishioners to send Christmas cards to all our military people serving in the various areas of our world. The Parish Nurses will be in the Meeting Room after all the Masses the weekend of November 11/12. Please join them to write out a card or two for our military personnel. All cards must be in by November 12<sup>th</sup> so that our military personnel will receive them in time for Christmas. ***Let's not forget them!!!!***

Don't forget next weekend we set our clocks back ***ONE HOUR***. Remember: ***"Fall back and Spring ahead."***
