Dear Parish Family:

“Love one another.” There are those words again. We have heard them so many times and will hear them so many times again before we leave this world. These words are at the very center of our lives. 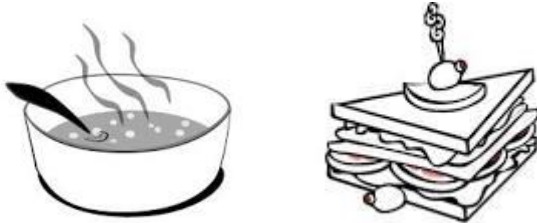
