Dear Parish Family:

How many times have we asked someone, "Pray for me"? How often have we promised another, "I'll pray for you!" Knowing that someone is praying for us is certainly a cause for encouragement and consolation. Likewise, keeping a promise to pray for another is a serious responsibility.

Our Gospel reading today begins with a clear, concise statement: "Lifting up His eyes to heaven, Jesus prayed." It is one of the few times we are privileged to hear Jesus actually praying. It is to our advantage then to listen carefully to his prayer. As we eavesdrop on Jesus, we notice what Jesus is NOT praying for. He is not praying for the spectacular success and triumph of his followers. He is not praying for their matter, physical needs such as food, clothing and shelter. He is not praying for their health or their wealth. So what then is He praying for His friends?

First, He's praying for all of us that we will continue to build on what His disciples started doing. He also is praying that His heavenly Father "that we may be one" just as He and His father are one. What a tremendous request. He also prays "that we may share His joy completely." He wants us to have joy in "good measure, packed together, shaken down, and overflowing." So then, this is the prayer of Jesus for us. What joy, what confidence, what courage we now have, knowing that Jesus is still praying for us!

Jesus' prayer is the model and standard for our own prayer. So the next time we tell someone, "I'll pray for you" or the next time we ask someone to "Pray for me," we can do no better than to pray as Jesus himself prayed.

Monday, May 28<sup>th</sup>, is Memorial Day. It's that time when we pause to remember all those men and women who answered the call of our nation and paid the ultimate sacrifice for the gift of freedom we enjoy each day. A tradition here at St. Barnabas is

our Memorial Day Mass at 9:00 a.m. I invite all our parishioners to come and together let us remember all our deceased loved ones in the various branches of the military and also pray for those who are still answering the call and serving in the military throughout the world.

Monday, June 11<sup>th</sup> is the Feast of St. Barnabas, our patronal feast day. In celebration of this feast, we will have a special concert in our Church on Sunday, June 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. Mr. Micheal Castaldo, an Italian tenor will perform for us various religious pieces and Italian musical selections. Tickets are \$25.00 and are now available at the rectory during business hours and also after all the weekend Masses. Mr. Castaldo will be here Sunday, May 27<sup>th</sup> to sing a couple of hymns at the Masses. Following the concert, there will be refreshments in Father Brennan Hall and the opportunity to meet Mr. Castaldo personally.

F.Y.I., your generosity towards the Maintenance Collection has helped to replace all the lightning in Father Brennan Hall, the Religious Article Shoppe, and the entire area outside of Father Brennan Hall. It's a big project, but the cost saving will be rewarding. We are in the process of obtaining a lift so as to change all the lightning of our parking lot lights. New improved lightning will make the parking lot brighter especially during the cold dark days of winter. (Let's not ever think of that now!!) During the summer we will replace the old doors of Rucki Hall. They are the original ones and have seen better days. We also are replacing our various exit signs in the buildings. Many of them are not working correctly and for safety reasons, new ones needed to be installed. Soon, we will be mulching all the gardens around the property for summer. There are still many more projects, but I just like to keep you posted on how grateful I am for your generosity in the maintenance collection and the work it is accomplishing. Thank you so very much!!!

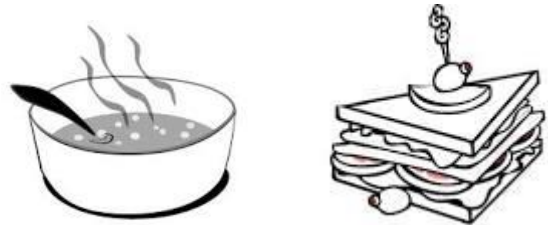
