Dear Parish Family:

“If a nation is torn by civil strife, that nation cannot last. If a household is divided according to loyalties, that household will not survive!” These are the words of Jesus spoken over 2000 years ago. And they are as true today as they were then. Any family is capable of becoming divided. Today’s gospel shows the closest relatives of Jesus were confused and indifferent. And when a family is divided there is usually very little that can be done to get them back.

In our world there are some causes of disunity, division and dissension. A principle one is “selfishness.” Selfishness is another word for “Sin.” Another is “DE Christianization.” That is “forgetting God,” cutting religious roots in our hearts, making God meaningless in our lives, replacing God with various contemporary idols of society. One reason for this dechristianization is the values we ingest from televisions and publications that have provided values that are usually not Catholic and barely Christian.

Our greatest source of unity is Jesus Christ. Our strongest defense against selfishness and dechristianized is a close relationship with Jesus. “Whoever does the will of God is brother and sister and mother to me!” There will always be a struggle to maintain unity within ourselves, our church and society, because we are sinners and sin of its nature is divisive. St. Paul experienced this; he kept his cool and sanity by looking beyond the troubles of this world to the world to come.

We too should fix our gaze, not on what is seen, but on what is unseen and remember that when life is over, we have a dwelling place provided for us by God that will last forever.

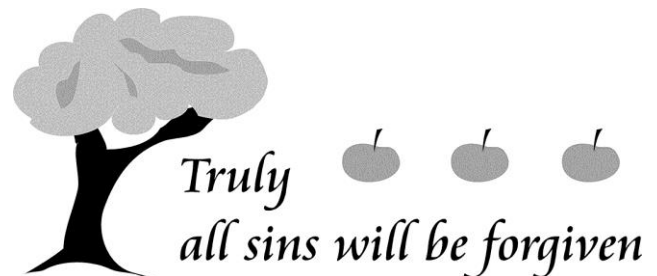

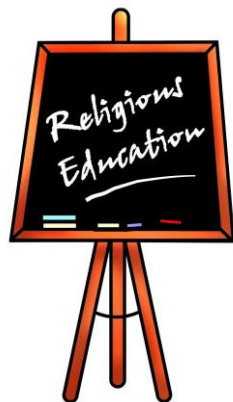
